

PLANNED PARENTHOOD AND WHITE SUPREMACY

It is interesting that we can trace the roots of Planned Parenthood back to 100 years ago in our nation's history. Margaret Sanger had a worldview that led to what we now see alive and well in our nation today. In her view there were certain beings not worthy of life. In her view it was called eugenics – good genetics. She thought she was smart enough to know just how to arrange the collective gene pool in America to reflect the best life possible for our nation. We might ask what this might have to do with white supremacy? It turned out that the most affected by "good genetics" were those of African descent. There are now more stepping stones being laid down based on many platforms. From these stepping stones will come more platforms. In other words, our nation is heading in a steady direction. And that direction is down. Of course, many will not agree with this appraisal of the direction of our nation. They have a different worldview. Just ask Ms. Sanger. We might also ask: "How can we bring the Judeo-Christian worldview back into our nation? And what ever happened to our National Motto?"

Consider stepping stones that lead to platforms. If more would get on the stepping stones that God has laid down for us we will then see more godly platforms. And from those platforms would come life more reflective of the life of God himself. The image of God would become more apparent and not struck down as hate speech. This leads us back into the issue of white supremacy and Planned Parenthood. The hate and vitriol surrounding these issues add fuel to the fire that is already burning. How can we put the fire out and stamp out the hate as well? It happens as soon as Jesus Christ becomes our stepping stone – our path. Then the platforms that come from him will lead to the blessing of new life. Some call this revival.

Platforms cannot be removed because we have lost the stepping stones that lead to the platforms of God's blessing. But once God's way becomes our way there will be no such thing as white supremacy. God will reign supreme. There will be no need for Planned Parenthood. God will be our heavenly Father and we'll follow his plan for parenthood. Our heavenly father will lay down his stepping stones that will lead to life and blessing spreading across our entire nation. God will be our platform, our Rock.
