C. S. Lewis wrote an essay on the nature of morals and the concept of natural law which are founded upon transcendent biblically-based ethics. Our land needs a Great Awakening. We need revival. Revival is a miracle of God. Revival is an extremely rare gift that God, in his grace, could still bestow upon a nation.

There must be humility and a willingness to be contrite over personal sins and the sins of our nation. However, it is a mysterious paradox that the contrition needed cannot even enter the scene without the help of Almighty God. So, we are in a fix. We are back to the need for revival.

Let's humbly pray and seek God for the miracle of sorrow over sin and that a heart of repentance toward God will flood our land.
