Psalm 119 is the longest chapter in the Bible. In this longest chapter we have many patterns to contemplate that help us contemplate the miracle that is God's Word. Psalm 119 is a blessed hymn to God's Word. This Psalm is full of poetic devices to help us take in the Word of God. And God wants his Word to do its miraculous work deep in our hearts.

Psalm 119 is divided up into 22 stanzas. Each stanza is represented by a different letter of the Hebrew alphabet as the psalm works through all 22 letters of the Hebrew alphabet. Each stanza contains 8 verses. Every line begins with a word with the same Hebrew letter assigned to that stanza.

We will be taking a deep look into the 10th stanza. Each line begins with the 10th letter of the Hebrew alphabet: Yodh (yode). In this "yodh stanza" the very first word in Hebrew is the word "hands" (Yad). It looks this way in our English translation: "Your hands made me and formed me; give me understanding to learn your commands" (Psalm 119:73). It is God's will that we know that his hand upon us. May the prayer that starts this 10th octave rise up to bless all who will choose to partake in God's Word.
